## **Community Iftar**

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you as we approach the Islamic month of Ramadan. For Muslims, Ramadan is a month of fasting and abstaining from things considered to be impure for the mind and body. Those partaking in Ramadan abstain from food, drink and impure thoughts between the hours of sunrise and sunset, allowing them instead to focus on prayer and reflection.

During this month, Iftar is held daily. This is a meal taken by Muslims at sundown to break the daily fast kept during Ramadan. The act of fasting is believed to encourage empathy for those who live their lives in poverty and famine, leaving the participant feeling more grounded and grateful for all that they have. This period culminates with the festival of Eid al-Fitr which translates as "the festival of the breaking of the fast".

Thornhill Community Academy are hosting their first ever Iftar on the evening of Thursday 14th March 2024. This is a perfect opportunity for parents and students to gain an insight into why our fellow Muslim students fast during the month of Ramadan. The Iftar event is open to all students and families (Muslim and non-Muslim) in every year group. Doors open at 5:15pm, the event will begin at 5:30pm, fast opens at 6:13pm, followed by a prayer (for those who wish to). The event will culminate with the opportunity for all attendees to join together for a hot meal.


