Students will listen to and analyse a number of classic Rock n Roll songs learning how each uses key features of the Blues (12 bar chord pattern/AAB structure) in preparation for their own practical work. Greater insight into the style's historical significance will be gained through a look at the slave trade as the context of its origins. | | |
