

The Thornhill Coat of Arms and School Motto (1964)



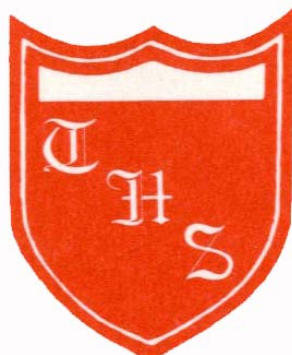
This wooden shield used to hang in the main hall and features the original emblem of the school. It is decorated with the school's coat of arms and motto '*I Serve*'.

The coat of arms and motto were also embroidered as a badge which was worn by pupils on the blazer pocket. This design was used until the mid 1980s.

School Logos



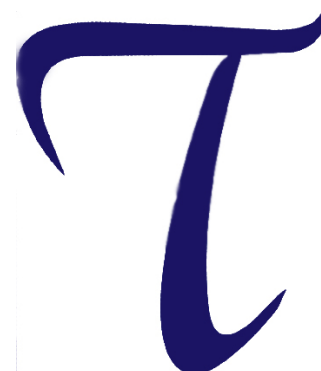
These red and blue logos were used from the mid to late 1980s. They were based on the original 1964 coat of arms and still contained the motto 'I Serve'.



By the 1990s this logo had been created. It was still based on the original shield and bore the same colours. The initials of 'THS' stood for *Thornhill High School*, which was the name of the school at that time.



In 2003 the school became *The Community Science College @Thornhill*. Both forms of the 'T' logo were used, which, of course, stood for Thornhill. The blue was also the colour of the school jumper.



On the 1st December 2012 the school became Thornhill Community Academy. A new logo was created. The rosette is in three colours which are used as part of the Academy's branding.
