I am writing to emphasise the importance of your child attending any detention that has been issued. When a pupil fails to attend a scheduled detention, it prevents us from resolving issues quickly and undermines the behaviour systems that keep our school calm, safe, and focused on learning. Non-attendance also results in more serious sanctions being put in place. These may include an after-school Senior Leadership Team detention, or, where necessary, time in Internal Exclusion. Repeated refusal to attend will lead to further escalation of consequences in line with our school behaviour policy.

We ask for your full support in ensuring your child attends their detention at the allocated time. Your cooperation helps us maintain high standards and ensures that your child has every opportunity to succeed within school.
