

Free School Meals

If you are in receipt of the following support payments your child may be entitled to receive free school meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on-paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

If you think your child is entitled to free school meals, you will usually need to complete an application form, this can be done online by visiting the Kirklees website and typing in 'Free school Meals' this will take you to an online application form or alternatively you could call the free school meals service on 01484 221928.

- Registering is confidential
- Taking up the meal is recommended but is not compulsory
- A cashless payment system is in operation at Royds Hall which should reduce the perceived stigma associated with free school meals
- Your child may receive additional help as a result of being registered, for example help with the cost of music lessons or one to one support
- Registering a child for free school meals will also qualify your child for a free breakfast

If you would like any more information about applying for free school meals please see your child's Head of Community or Mrs Wilson.
