Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to say that students have reported that the vast majority of the summer exams so far have gone well. Students have spoken positively about feeling prepared, ready, and we are very proud of how they're conducting themselves.

Whilst students do not officially leave until 30/06/2022, we will be hosting a celebration assembly this Friday, 27th May in line with tradition. It is hoped that this will be a wonderful celebration of their five year journey through TCA, albeit with chunks of year 9 and 10 being from home. They will then be able to leave the Academy after lunch on Friday.
