



Student Remote Learning: What, When, How?

Dear Student,

If you are not attending lessons due to self-isolation, please make sure you are doing the following:

- Stick to your timetable and complete lessons on MS Teams as if you were in school. This is especially important if your bubble has been closed and you need to attend live lessons. Check your calendar in Teams to make sure you are joining lessons at the right time
- Email your teachers if you need support. You can use the guides on the Remote and Home Learning page to help with this
- Try to keep to the deadlines set by your teachers, especially with coursework tasks
- Don't forget to complete home learning. Check your class teams each day to make sure you have accessed and completed tasks as they are added
- Check your Outlook email daily. Teachers may email you with additional information, further work that needs completing and may want you to email work to them so that they can give you feedback.
- Be proactive – use online resources and apps such as PixL Apps, GCSE Pod and MathsWatch to catch up on anything you have missed, revise content you have already covered and to continue learning. Use the time out of the Academy on the things that you personally need to.
- Be creative and seek support. If you cannot access a laptop or desktop computer, use your smartphone to take pictures of your work and hand them in / email them to your teachers!
- And finally, read lots! Then read a bit more...

Please remember – Be Nice and Work Hard. You can do these at home as much as at school!
