

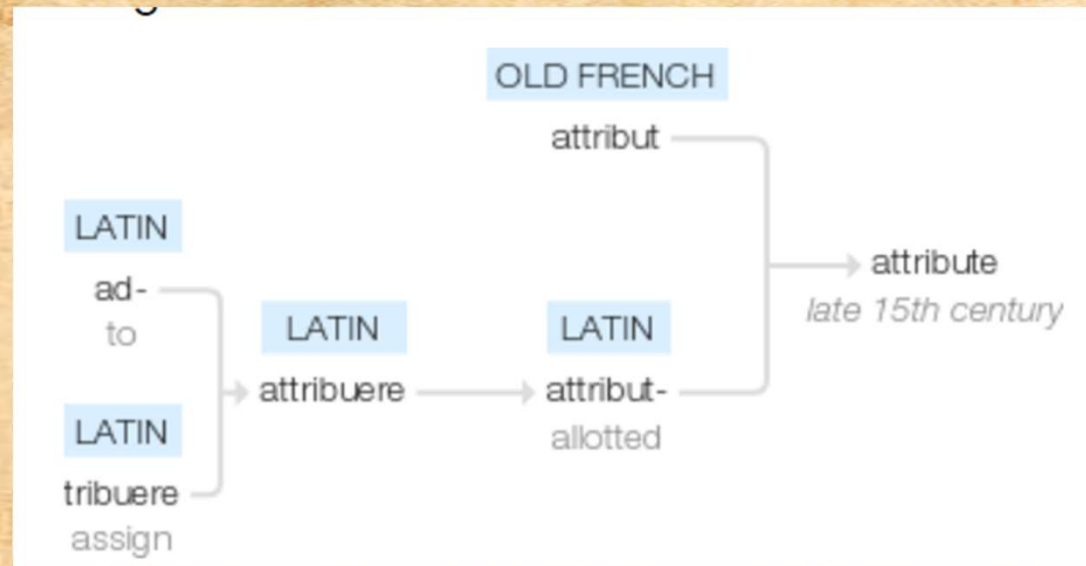
Attribute

Definition: (verb) to regard something as being caused by something or (noun) a quality regarded as a characteristic of someone or something.



Etymology:

The study of the origin (beginning) of words
